

Autumn Hawkbit





Autumn Hawkbit (Ceontodon autumnalis) have loose clusters and normally bloom from July to October. The plant grows one single wildflower per stem, each around 3cm in diameter and at a height of 10-40cm.

This species is common in late summer and throughout the autumn and can be found in a wide variety of habitats. It is capable of growing on sites which has a high disturbance level such as those used for cutting and grazing. It requires a relatively fertile soil to be able to grow in high numbers.

This wildflower is perfect for pollinators.

Sowing Time: Spring
