

Greater Birdsfoot



Greater Birdsfoot (*Lotus pedunculatus*) flowers from June to late August followed by distinctive pods. Greater Birdfoot seed is a brownish green compared to the reddish brown of Common Birdsfoot. It spreads by stolons and to a lesser extent by seed.

Found on a range of damp grassland including wet meadows, rush pastures, marshes, ponds, lakes and rivers with a preference towards acidic soils. Greater Birdsfoot is the only British legume found in wetlands.

Sowing Time: Spring/Autumn
