

Forget-Me-Not



Forget-Me-Not (Myosotis Scorpioides) are usually biennial, meaning they will flower and normally die in the second year, this is when they set seed. Has blue flowers with five petals growing in a slightly disorderly manner which grow on thick stems.

A location with partial shade to have success in Forget-Me-Nots, these flowers prefer moist soil. Once flowered the entire plant will die, including leaves and stem which will dry out. Leave plants in place until the fall to allow the seeds to sow themselves naturally.

Forget-Me-Nots are pollinated by small flies and hymenopterans.

Sowing Time: August/September

Sowing Depth/Spacing: Sow 1/4 deep and at least 10 inches apart to allow room for adult plants.
