

Foxglove





Foxglove (Digitalis Purpurea) grow on stems which may reach 6 feet high depending on the variety. Foxglove flowers are in clusters which are tubular shaped in a variety of colours; white, lavender, yellow and pink.

They are hardy flowers, however, the hotter the summer the more shade the flower will require. Foxgloves thrive in rich, well drained soil. The soil does need to be moist to encourage re-growth. Foxglove plants will drop seeds once the flowers dry on the stalk.

Sowing Time: For flowers for the following year sow in the Summer.

Sowing Depth/Spacing: 18 inches apart allows room to develop
