



Goatsbeard



Goatsbeard (*Aruncus dioicus*) is a perennial with feathery plumes of creamy white, star shaped flowers which rise well above its green foliage. Blooming from early to mid summer, this clump forming perennial slowly grows to 4-6ft tall and spreads 2-4ft wide.

It thrives in average, medium to wet, well drained soils and part shade is preferred. This is an excellent background plant for shady and moist areas. Recommended companion plants consist of Sneezeweed, Lambs Ears and Purple Cranesbill.

Sowing Time: Spring/Autumn
