

Great Mullein





Great Mullein (Verbascum thapsus) is an erect biennial. In its first year grows a large, dense leaf rosette and in the second year develops its flowering stem. With light yellow flowers reaching 3cm across. Each flower opens for a couple of days but the flowering stem itself can last for months. Blooming occurs in July through to September.

Great Mullein prefers full sun with a dry location. Grows in a variety of soil types that are free draining, finding it in waste grounds and rough grasslands.

Fertiliser is not necessary.

Sowing Time: Spring
