

Meadow Cranesbill



Meadow Cranesbill (Geranium pratense) is a medium to tall grassland perennial with deeply cut leaves and long, hairy reddish stems. The flowers consist of five un-notched violet petals, flowering from June to September.

Meadow Cranesbill is native to most of Great Britain except the north west of Scotland, but is absent from Ireland. It prefers calcareous soils and habitats include verges, stream sides and damp hay meadows.

Sowing Time: Spring/Autumn
