

Plantain Hoary



Plantain Hoary (Plantago media) has tiny flowers that are arranged into dense spike that sits upon an unbranched, leafless stem which arises from a basal rosette. The basal rosette is flat with broad, oval leaves narrowing to a short stalk. Flowering occurs from May through to late August.

Plantain Hoary thrives of chalk and limestone soils but can be found on heavy clays and water meadows. It looks best growing with other chalk and limestone plants such as Oxeye daisies, Kidney vetch and Greater knapweed.

Sowing Time: Autumn
