

Saw-wort



Saw-wort (*Serratula tinctoria*) is a native perennial growing up to 1m in height. Flowers are reddish purple, reaching up to 2cm.

Saw-wort has a preference for damp sites but will grow in a variety of soil types in sun or dappled sites. In gardens, Saw-wort can be grown in summer flowering meadows or hedgerows. Saw-wort looks best with other wild flowers that bloom in mid summer such as Meadow Sweet, Meadow Vetchling, Great Burnet and Meadow Cranesbill.

Sowing Time: Spring/Autumn
