

## Lesser Stitchwort



**Lesser Stitchwort (*Stellaria graminea*) the flowers have long, narrow white petals with alternate long green sepals. The leaves are un-stalked and narrow, which the flowers being much smaller than greater stitchwort. The flower has five petals which are lobed until the base.**

**In Britain and Ireland it flowers in late May to late June. Lesser Stitchwort grows on neutral and acid soils in open woodland, meadows and hedge banks.**
