

Lesser Stitchwort



Lesser Stitchwort (Stellaria graminea) the flowers have long, narrow white petals with alternate long green sepals. The leaves are un-stalked and narrow, which the flowers being much smaller then greater stitchwort. The flower has five petals which are lobed until the base.

In Britain and Ireland it flowers in late May to late June. Lesser Stitchwort grows on neutral and acid soils in open woodland, meadows and hedge banks.

Sowing Time: Spring
