

Wild Strawberry



Wild Strawberry (Fragaria vesca) has glossy, trefoil leaves with toothed edges and hairy undersides. It has got white flowers with five petals and a golden centre and has distinctive red fruit with tiny seeds. Flowering from April to July followed by fruiting.

Wild Strawberries grow in open, well drained places in lowland areas. These plants can be found in fields, meadows and open forests. Wild Strawberry look best growing alongside other woodland wildflowers such as Greater Stitchwort, Red Campion and Wood Avens.

Sowing Time: Autumn
