

Kale

Thousand Head Kale

- Traditionally used for game cover, but can be grazed after the shooting season.
- A variety of medium height at around 150cm tall.
- Particularly winter hardy.
- Good lodging resistance.
- A proven, reliable variety with prolific growth.
- Provides nutritious leaves throughout the winter.

Inka Kale

- Giant variety. Very tall.
- Game cover and grazing uses.
- Very high yielding.
- Medium leaf to stem ratio.
- Perfect for winter maintenance of larger livestock.
- Developed with the dairy grazer in mind.
- Consistently delivers on yield and is well adapted to colder climates.
- Sown late spring for winter grazing.
- Tolerates harsh conditions.

Marrow Stem Kale

- Winter Hardy.
 - High dry mass yield.
- Forage use.

Burly Kale

- Giant variety.
- Good tall cover.
- Bred for palatability. Has a palatable sweet stem.
- High dry matter yield.
- Consistent variety that will tolerate a wide range of soil types.
- Performs well in various conditions inc. cold, wet and dry.

Voltage Kale

- Medium height variety.
- Good standing ability.
- For game cover and forage uses.
