

# Million Pollinator Garden Challenge

If you create a pollinator garden, whether this is for bees or butterflies, you can certify it with the National Wildlife Federation. It also counts towards the Million Pollinator Garden Challenge which is a campaign to register a million public and private gardens and landscapes to support pollinators. This nationwide call is to preserve and create gardens and landscapes that help revive the health of bees, butterflies and birds.



There are several ways to do this:-

1. Plant a pollinator garden
2. Support pollinator friendly businesses – purchase plants or seeds from nurseries, garden centres and seed suppliers who offer pollinator-friendly plants and seeds suited to your local area.
3. Register your garden to BEE counted
4. Plant sustainably – reduce or eliminate the impact of pesticides on pollinators, conserve water and provide an overall healthy habitat for pollinators and people.
5. Spread the word of this challenge.
